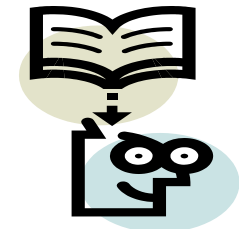
Get ready to set the clocks an hour ahead, wear your green

A LITTLE SPICE BY PHYLLIS THOMAS

Moist Pumpkin Bars

- 4 cups of flour
- 2 cups uncooked
oatmeal
- 2 tsp baking soda
- 2 tsp cinnamon
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 1/2 cup of margarine
or butter
- 2 cups of brown sugar
- 1 cup white sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 30 oz can pumpkin
- 1 cup raisins

1 cup chopped walnuts
(optional)
Preheat oven to 350
degrees Melt butter or
margarine and set aside
to cool. Mix flour oats,
soda, and salt and set
aside. Cream butter and
both sugars together.
Add eggs and vanilla,
mix well. Take turns
adding pumpkin and dry
ingredients. Add raisins
and walnuts , mixing
well. Pour into sheet

cake pan and spread out
evenly. Bake for 45 to
55 minutes. When
cooled, you can spread
icing on. Then cut into
squares or bars.

Icing

- 1 cup powdered sugar
 - 1 TB butter softened
 - 1/2 tsp vanilla extract
 - 3 tsp milk
 - 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- Mix well and spread.

**Cottage Cheese
Dessert**

- 1 24 oz cottage cheese
- 1 cup white mini
marshmallows
- 8 oz. Cool Whip
- 1 reg size can of fruit

cocktail or other fruit
1 small box red Jell-O
powder (cherry,
strawberry or raspberry.
Drain the fruit before
adding to other
ingredients. Mix well

and chill before serving.
This tastes better if
made the night before.
For fewer calories, use
lite, fat free and sugar
free ingredients.
